Report of Anti-Doping Matter

In accordance with Article 14.3 of the World Karate Federation Anti-Doping Rules ("WKF ADR"), the WKF hereby reports that the Athlete <u>Mr Bahman ASGARI GHONCHEH</u> (Islamic Republic of Iran) has violated Article 2.1 of the WKF ADR - Presence of a Prohibited Substance or its Metabolites or Markers in an Athlete's sample.

More precisely, a sample collected *In-Competition* from Mr Bahman ASGARI GHONCHEH on 2 May 2021 revealed the Presence of the prohibited substance *clomifene* and its metabolite, a substance prohibited at all times under class S4. Hormones and Metabolic Modulators of the 2021 World Anti-Doping Agency Prohibited List.

The Athlete has been sanctioned as follows:

- 1. Mr Bahman ASGARI GHONCHEH has committed a violation of Article 2.1 of the WKF ADR;
- 2. Mr Bahman ASGARI GHONCHEH is suspended for a period of Ineligibility of 12 months;
- 3. The period of Ineligibility starts on the date Mr Bahman ASGARI GHONCHEH was provisionally suspended, i.e. on 14 June 2021, and shall remain in full force and effect until 13 June 2022;
- 4. Mr Bahman ASGARI GHONCHEH's competitive results achieved from the date of sample collection (i.e. 2 May 2021) until the start of the period of Ineligibility (i.e. 14 June 2021) are disqualified, with all the resulting consequences, including forfeiture of any medals, points and prizes.
